Our site oversees the sponsorship program for both children and elders across five locations. In addition to sponsorship, the site provides adult skills training workshops on baking, embroidering, sewing, leadership, and entrepreneurship. Dominica site also has a partnership with a local health centre to provide checkups for the children and elderly.



Education

Goals

1. To continue to analyze strategies to strengthen and improve the education of children and young people attending schools and colleges.
2. To continue with the sewing, bakery and other workshops that may arise through agreements with the SNPP.
3. To reduce teenage pregnancy rates.

Achievements

1. The Basic School for Young People and Adults N° 11-432, under the Ministry of Education and Sciences located inside the San Pedro Chapel, continues to operate.
2. An agreement was signed with SNPP, for training in different areas, for fathers, mothers, youth and adolescents of the Dominica Site.
3. Parents understand the importance of supporting their children's education.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To obtain agreements with the Ministry of Public Health to have permanent professionals in different areas.
2. To talk about prevention of teenage pregnancy.

Achievements

1. Conducted general maintenance of the dispensary and operation of a dental office with dental chair, radiographic equipment, halogen light.
2. Offered voluntary support of dental medical professionals.
3. A workshop was conducted on the correct handling of food.



Nutrition

Goals

1. Continue with the nutrition program in order to support our Children's Dining Room.
2. Generate more interest in our community about this program.
3. Invite supermarkets and merchandise distribution companies in the community to participate in the Dining Room program.

Achievements

1. Thanks to our nutrition program and volunteers, more than 130 children have been provided with food each day from Monday to Friday.
2. Mothers improved their hygiene habits in food preparation.
3. Families enjoy variety in their menu.



Family and Community

Goals

1. Continue training our Chalice Family Circles
2. To train and support families in conflict on family and community issues that induce total recovery.

Achievements

1. Conducted training of 37 CFCs with an excellent approval rating.
2. Constructed two homes and bathrooms.
3. Provided replacements of beds, mattresses and pillows damaged by rains and storms.
