Our site approaches the population through actions aimed at strengthening families and/or communities, and improving education. We seek to develop leadership skills, entrepreneurship, financial education and management of family and collective savings from the same family circles. We also support and accompany people over the age of 65 in situations of vulnerability due to desertion and extreme poverty.



Education

Goals

1. Direct beneficiaries of Chalice have the necessary materials and tools for learning.
2. Parents receive training on the importance of formal education for their children's future from the Chalice Family Circles.

Achievements

1. 100% of the schools attended by more than 80% of the recipients were visited and interviewed with teachers to verify the educational process of the recipients.
2. 80% of the Chalice Family Circles prioritized the purchase of school supplies.
3. 70% of the CFCs that planned the purchase of school supplies made the purchases in the quarters established by them.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To ensure that direct beneficiaries and their families receive advice and information on drug procurement through public health institutions.
2. To provide medicines through donations.

Achievements

1. CFCs are aware of the importance of prevention and health care.
2. Through grant funds, medicines and hospital supplies were procured for recipients in emergency and special cases.
3. 100% control was carried out on funds destined for elderly people and people in chronic or serious situation in relation to the purchase of medicine.



Nutrition

Goals

1. To encourage direct and indirect beneficiaries to put into practice good consumption habits for their food security.
2. To help elderly people access nutritious food.

Achievements

1. CFC's receive information through meetings with field workers on the importance and management of healthy eating from home through the proper use of FFS in the area of food.
2. Direct and indirect beneficiaries put into practice good consumption habits for their food security.



Family & Community

Goals

1. To ensure that families and trained in financial education and use funds as planned.
2. To raise awareness for the families to recognize the problems of their environment and to work together with activities that promote solidarity with the most needy in the community.



Achievements

1. 100% of the CFCs and their member families were accompanied by spiritual and socioeconomic orientations.
2. Almost 300 children attend weekly meetings on human and spiritual formation based on Salesian pedagogy.
3. 100% of the CFCs receive training, orientation and accompaniment in Financial Education.
