



Our Haiti North site currently supports over 1700 sponsored children. Children benefit from school feeding programs supported by our nutrition program. In addition to sponsorship, our site conducts health checks for children, provides nutrition workshops for parents, and runs a successful community poultry cooperative program.



Education

Goals

1. To continue to support our sponsored children to ensure they'll have a better future.
2. To mitigate delinquency and crime by educating a large part of the children's community in our region.

Achievements

1. Our support for sponsored children has been successful. This year, **50** students who are graduating from high school will continue their studies in university.
2. This year we had the opportunity to spread the impact of our work further. We expanded our intervention areas in order to send a considerable amount of children in our community to school.

Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To provide two clinics in Terrier-Rouge and Grand Bassin with the necessary equipment to improve the quality of services offered to the community.
2. To encourage another medical mission to support both clinics.



Achievements

1. This year we led a medical mission thanks to the enormous support of the Chalice team and the medical team. This medical mission allowed the people of Terrier-Rouge and Grand Bassin to be treated for their health problems.
2. Thanks to grant money support, we helped two sponsored children receive treatment for injuries sustained from accidents.

Nutrition

Goals

1. To fight malnutrition and vitamin deficiency by providing children with a healthy breakfast in schools for better learning.
2. To give parents the support needed to properly feed their children.

Achievements

1. We helped address malnutrition in schools by distributing food, thus encouraging better learning.
2. We improved knowledge of the parents through training sessions and workshops on nutrition for a better attitudes and practices on this subject.



Community

Goals

1. To have sufficient product from our poultry co-op business to meet the needs of our customers, and to improve the quality of our products that we offer.

Achievements

1. We have increased the number of laying hens in our chicken barn so that we can have more eggs to meet the needs of the customers. We also have enough to donate some to students through our nutrition program.

Family

Goals

1. To reduce the burden on parents during back to school time. Many poor families can't afford to buy school supplies for their children.

Achievements

2. This year, with gift catalogue funds, we distributed school bags to all our sponsored children, so that they can go back to school with a good school bag to carry their books.

Family funding

Goals

1. To help them develop an idea of cooperation between parents.
2. To help parents to have adequate knowledge on credit and loans so that they can manage their money to have means to take care of their families.



Achievements

1. Family funding has been working well. Parents have begun to understand the importance of the family circle groups. Some groups give loans to members to start small businesses.
2. Parents have realized that family funding allows them to manage their money well in order to spend it for useful purposes.
