Our site works with children who are from the outskirts of society, like orphans, migrants, marginalized groups, the general poor and elders who have no income to manage their needs. In addition to sponsorship, our site provides health care and nutrition programs.



Education

Goals

1. To ensure that all parents set goals to improve the educational growth of their children.
2. To conduct a career guidance program for 82 children from grades nine to 12.

Achievements

1. 100 % of our sponsored children are attending school.
2. 82 children successfully completed their grade 10 and are in higher secondary education now.
3. 31 children completed higher secondary education and are in graduation or technical studies.
4. Four children completed graduation courses.
5. Two children completed post graduation/technical studies and are fetching income to the family.
6. Organised an annual gathering of children that 3011 children participated in it.



Health & hygiene

Goals

1. To assess health conditions of sponsored children through health camps.
2. To record the BMI of each child and follow up in improving the health of children.

Achievements

1. Organised a medical camp for 1076 sponsored children and elderly.
2. Launched a critical needs fund to help a mother of a sponsored child receive medical treatment.
3. Conducted an awareness session on health for 39 elders.
4. Conducted a workshop for teens for 85 youth and one on value systems for 115 children.



Nutrition

Goals

1. To give parents an orientation on nutritional food management in the family.

Achievements

1. All sponsored children and elderly have regular access to nutritious food.
2. Every child's health was stable, according to the assessment during the health camp.



Family and community

Goals

1. To help families have their own kitchen gardens at home.
2. To encourage parents to start income generating programs.

Achievements

1. 218 women and youth acquired skills in tailoring and computers through skills training.



Family funding

Goals

1. To make all family circle members set their own short term goals for the next one to two years.

Achievements

1. Organised an orientation for the office bearers of 334 family circles on the maintenance of books of accounts
2. 80% of the family circles started an internal loaning system.
